Supplemental NT reading: John 15:4–11

- 23 Some went down to the sea in ships,  
doing business on the great waters;*  
*24 they saw the deeds of the LORD,  
his wondrous works in the deep.*  
*25 For he commanded and raised the stormy wind,  
which lifted up the waves of the sea.*  
*26 They mounted up to heaven; they went down to the

and makes them wander in trackless wastes;*
- 41 but he raises up the needy out of affliction  
and makes their families like flocks.*
- 42 The upright see it and are glad,  
and all wickedness shuts its mouth.*
- 43 Whoever is wise, let him attend to these things;  
let them consider the steadfast love of the LORD.*
