PREPARATION

CALL TO WORSHIP From Psalm 19:1-14

LEADER: The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

RESPONSE: Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge.

LEADER: There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard.

RESPONSE: Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

LEADER: In them he has set a tent for the sun, which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy.

RESPONSE: Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them, and there is nothing hidden from its heat.

LEADER: The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;

RESPONSE: The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;
