Lord, thank You that in the midst of our faltering belief, You have provided a strong and powerful Savior. Though Satan's accusations ring in our ears and threaten to undo us, You have declared us righteous and blameless in Your sight because of Christ. You are the Great King of the Universe, the Lord Almighty. Silence our mouths when we condemn ourselves, and settle our frightened souls when we tremble with fear before You. Show us how Your wrath toward our sin has been emptied on Your precious Son, and let us feel deeply in our souls that Jesus has paid for every sin with his bleeding wounds.

Holy Spirit, give us eyes to see our Savior, pleading for us as he bears deep wounds that proclaim, "No condemnation." Give us growing faith to believe in Your relentless love for us, and strong minds to discern Your truth from Satan's lies. Please grant us joyful hope to long for heaven, and grace to find rest and contentment in You on our journey there.

## PREACHING OF THE WORD

### The Truth That Sets Free

#### John 8:31-47

*So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, <sup>32</sup> and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." <sup>33</sup> They answered him, "We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, 'You will become free'?"*

*<sup>34</sup> Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. <sup>35</sup> The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. <sup>36</sup> So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. <sup>37</sup> I know that you are offspring of Abraham; yet you seek to kill me because my word finds no place in you. <sup>38</sup> I speak of what I have seen with my Father, and you do what you have heard from your father."*

*<sup>39</sup> They answered him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did, <sup>40</sup> but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did. <sup>41</sup> You are doing the works your father did." They said to him, "We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father—even God." <sup>42</sup> Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me. <sup>43</sup> Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word. <sup>44</sup> You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. <sup>45</sup> But because I tell the truth, you do not believe me. <sup>46</sup> Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me? <sup>47</sup> Whoever is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God."*
